As with many of the new convertibles there are OEM parts that cannot be reproduced but are needed for the replacement top. This stands true with the Beetle. WE will require the complete rear window frame with brackets in order to produce the new top. WE have inventory of the necessary window frames and can offer a core charge on them to save time. List price in SG11 (Blk/Blk Sonnend) is \$1540.00 and the core charge, which will be refunded when the OEM rear window frame and brackets are returned, is \$350.00 wholesale. The Factory original material is German Sonnenland which list price is \$1840.00 in GR11 & GR61.
